If you live and/or have a business within one of the five Tulare Lake Subbasin's groundwater sustainability agencies (GSAs), the Groundwater Sustainability Plan (GSP) will affect the way your groundwater is managed! Join us for a public outreach meeting regarding the Sustainable Groundwater Management Act (SGMA) and the draft Groundwater Sustainability Plan.

The Sustainable Groundwater Management Act is a California law passed in 2014 that will change the way we use and manage groundwater. The El Rico GSA, Mid-Kings River GSA, South Fork Kings GSA, Southwest Kings GSA, and Tri-County Water Authority have been collaborating to decide how much groundwater will be available, how it will be shared, and how to sustain and replenish groundwater levels.
