

subsidence is occurring. Information presented by Thomas Harder along the Friant Kern Canal in Eastern Tule GSA shows 43% of the subsidence is happening below 1,180 feet. There are very few wells in the region that are at that depth or more. Amer then explained the public review process for the updated GSP for SFKGSA.

Director Neves asked Amer about the interaction between the City of Lemoore and SFKGSA. Amer explained that we now have meetings scheduled with the Engineers working for the city. Johnny also has a meeting scheduled with the new city manager, Marisa Trejo.

Amer then presented the New Contract for 2025 for Consulting and Engineering Services with a budget of up to \$60,000 for board approval. Johnny explained that the contract would put us over the budget for engineering services, but there are other budget items that have not been utilized to make up the difference. The total budget will not be exceeded.

Actions:

It was moved by Director Newton and seconded by Director Mercer to enter into the new contract for Engineering support and Consulting Services for 2025 with a total budget of \$60,000.
